- ⇒ 12.45 Sprints - 100m, 75m, 50m and relays. (Age dependent on distance)

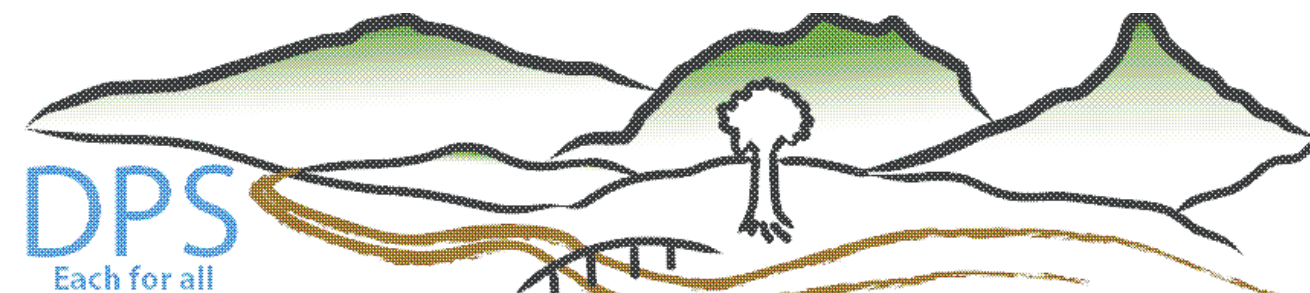

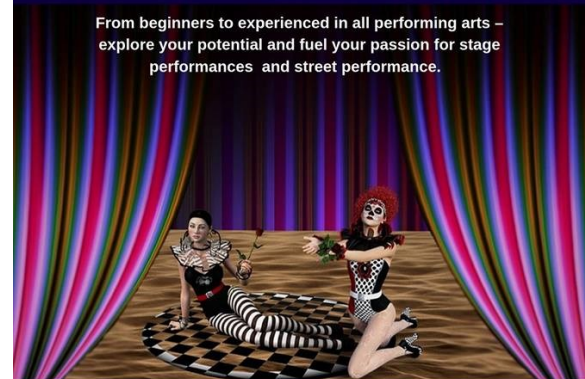
