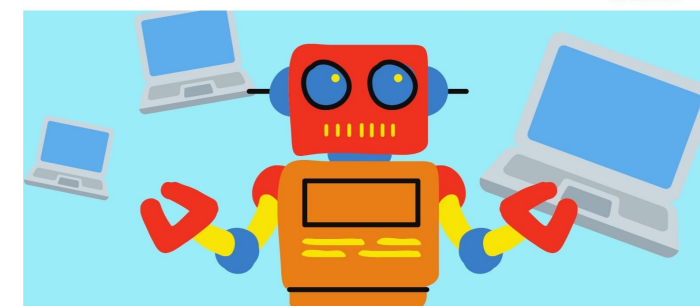
**Any cancellation or postponement will be made by 7.30am on the Saturday. This will be placed on our 'NWNC Junior Netball' Facebook page.**
